

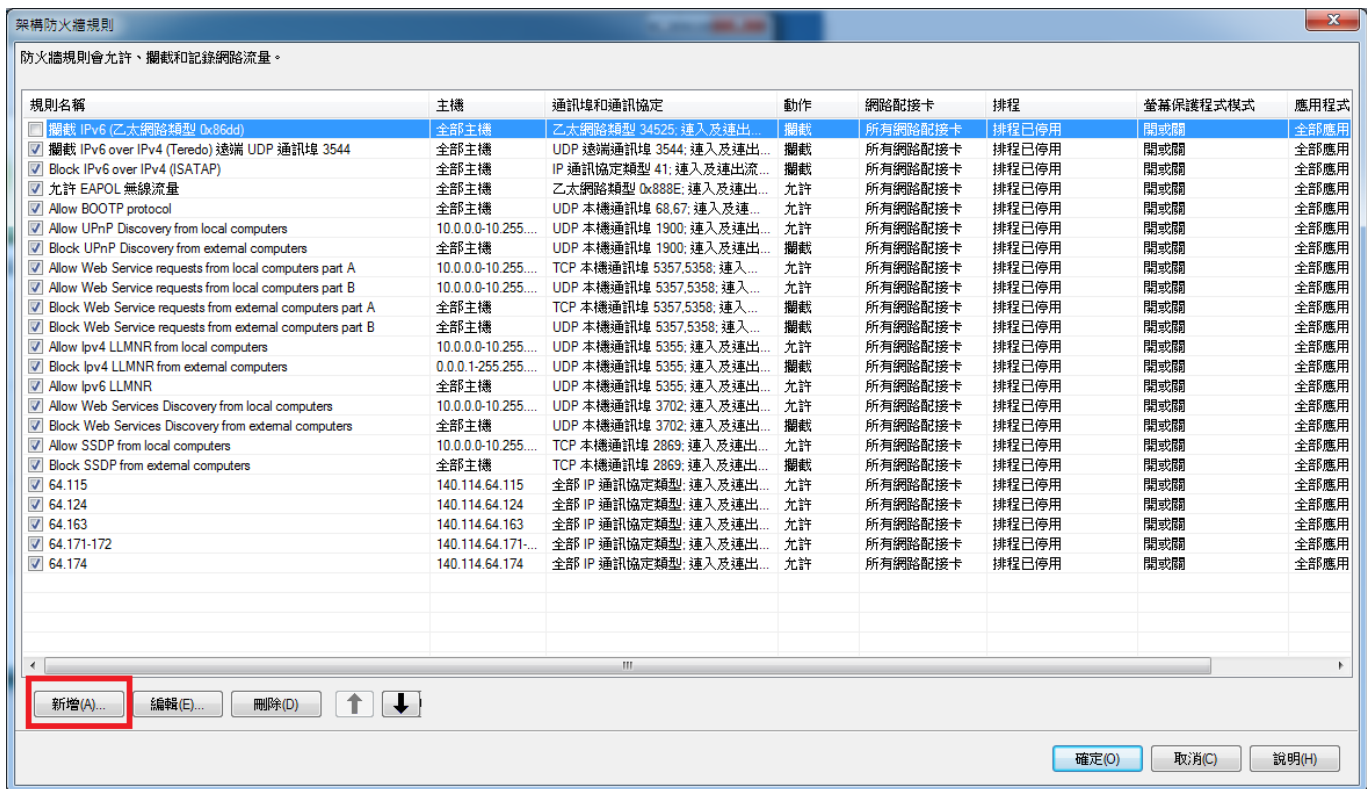
# How to prevent open DNS resolver by setting up Symantec Firewall

We can prevent PC running open DNS resolver by changing firewall setting. We'll take Symantec as an example, please follow these step.

- Turn on Symantec Endpoint Protection, click **Network threat Protection**, and then select **configure firewall rules**

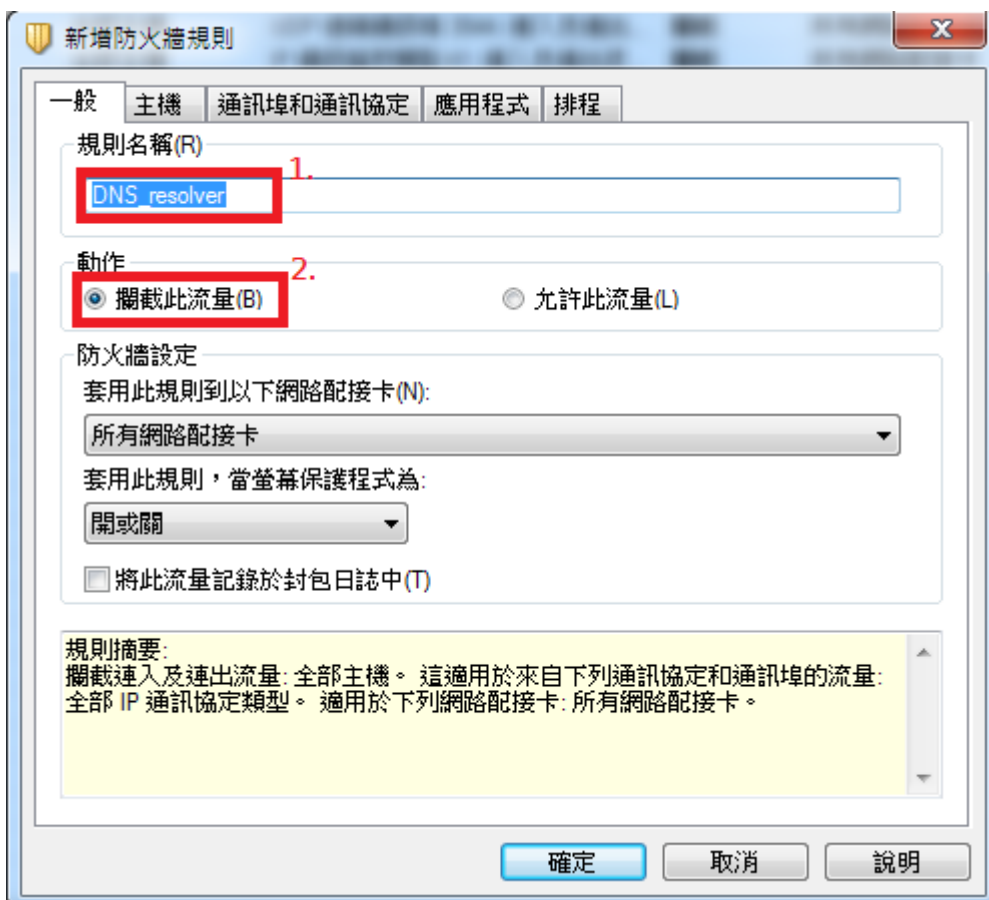


- In **configure firewall rules** dialog box , click **Add**

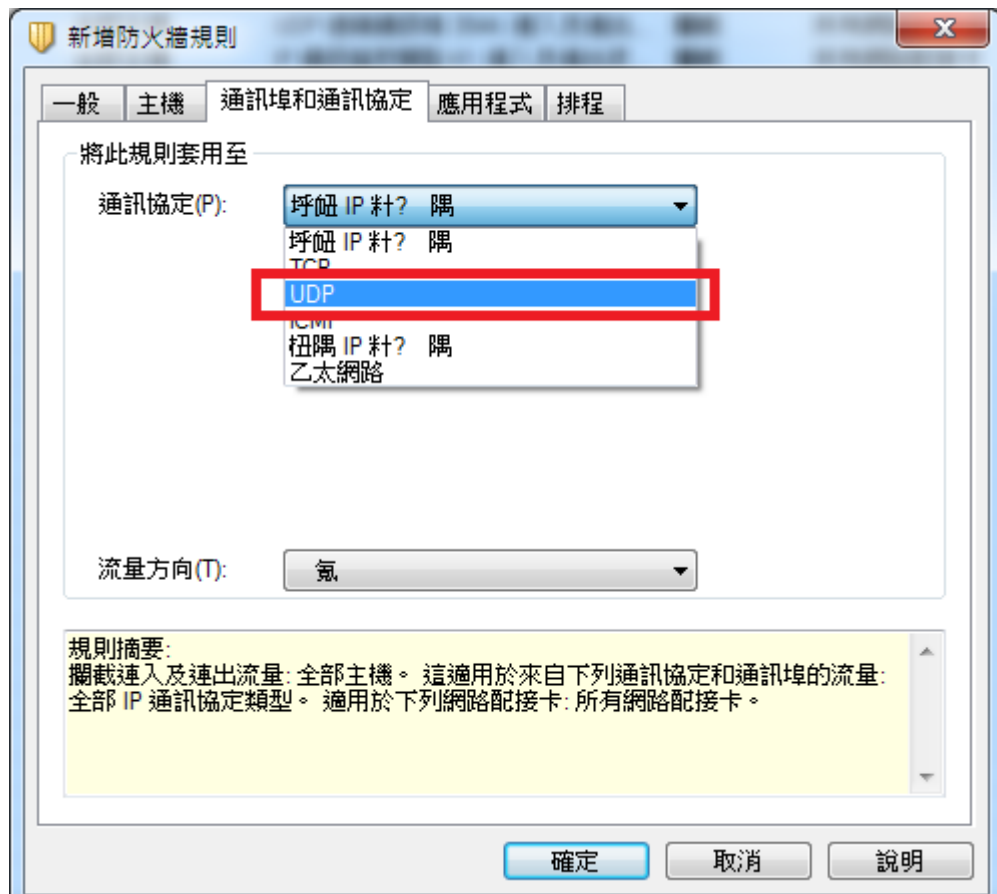


• In Add Firewall Rule

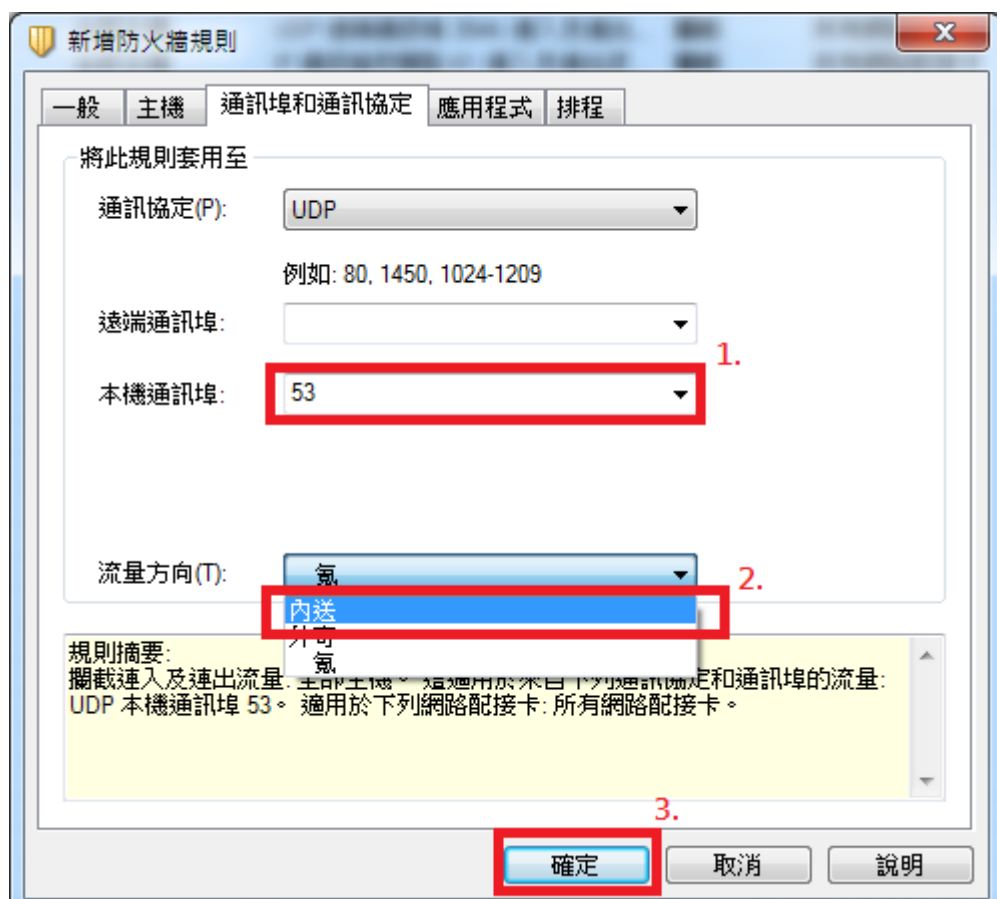
1. Give the **rule name** and type in text box, for example: DNS\_resolver
2. Select **Block this traffic**



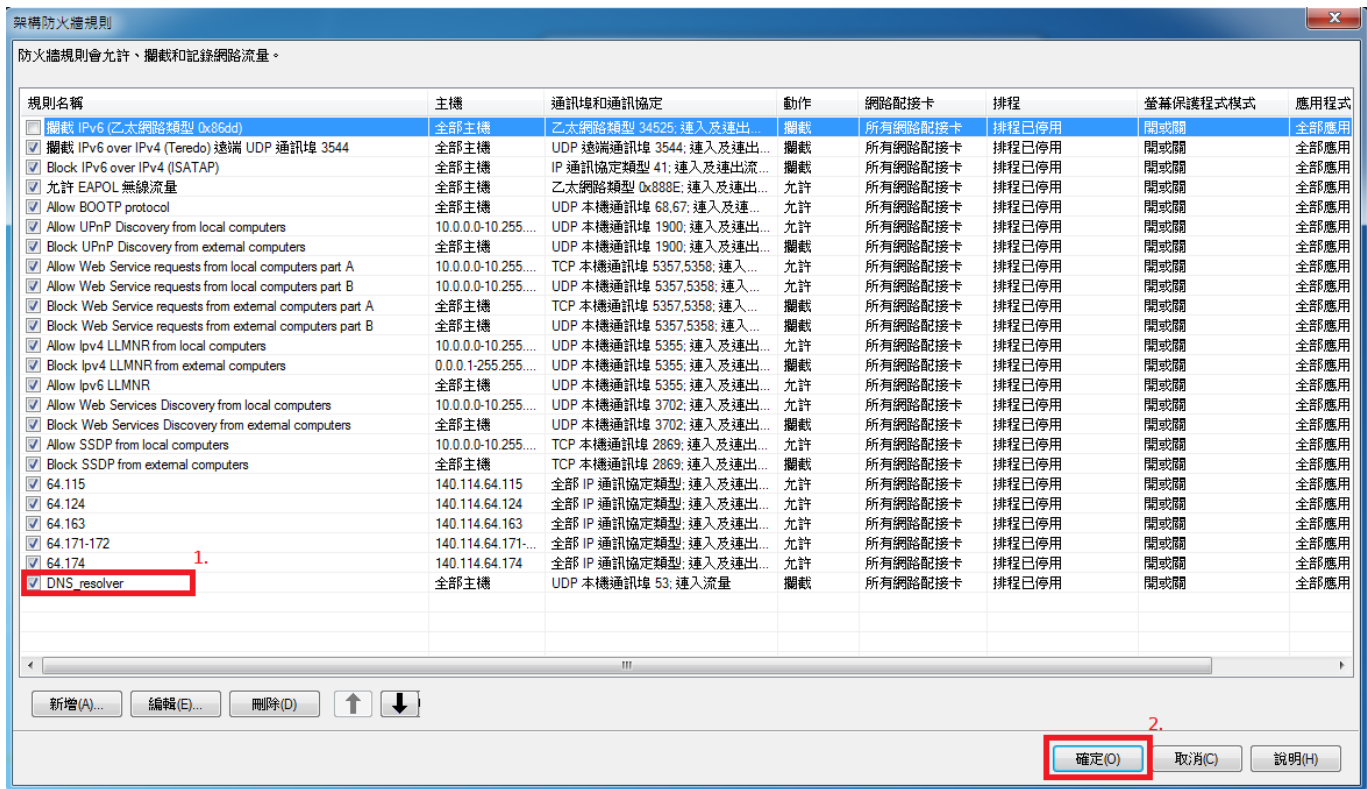
1. Click the tab for **Ports and Protocols**
2. choose **UDP** from dropdown for Protocol



1. Type **53** in the Local Ports field
2. Choose **Incoming** in dropdown for Traffic direction
3. Click **OK**



1. Check that "DNS\_resolver" has shown in configure firewall rules dialog box
2. Click **OK**



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
