Recently, Broadcom released a critical security vulnerability announcement (CVE-2025-41225, CVSS: 8.8). This is a verified command execution vulnerability that allows attackers with create or modify permissions to execute arbitrary commands via scripts, thereby performing unauthorized operations on the vCenter Server.
